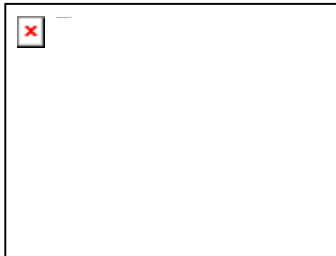
St. Valentine—Patron Saint of Lovers
